AFTER-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES 2019/2020 Term 2

Welcome to Term 2 of the After-School Activities for 2019/20.

After-school activities are organised by a voluntary sub-committee of the Board of Management. The current After School Committee members are Kate Butler and Gary Fitzgerald. The committee can be contacted on <u>afterschool@d7educatetogether.com</u>.

This term will run from Monday 27th January to Friday 22nd May and will comprise **14 weeks of classes (Elbow Room will provide 16-18 weeks)**. Midterm closure is 17th to 21st February inclusive; St Patrick's closure is on 16th and 17th March; Easter closure is 6th to 17th April inclusive; May bank holiday closure is Monday 4th; June bank holiday closure is Monday 1st to Wednesday 3rd inclusive.

There are currently 3 different types of after school activities – 1) School based 2) Swimming at Inspire 3) The Elbowroom.

The Afterschool Committee is responsible for the registration of **school based activities**; other providers should be contacted directly to book a place for your child in their classes.

The online registration system will be in operation for all classes taking place in the school and payment of fees will also be made through the online system.

<u>Please note that some classes will run for less than 14 weeks and this will be indicated on the individual webpages.</u>

1. <u>School Based Activities</u>

School-based activities run from 2:15 to 3:15 pm and classes are available from 1st class through to 6th class.

General Information
